READ ALL ABOUT IT... Mermaids found on Cornish beach



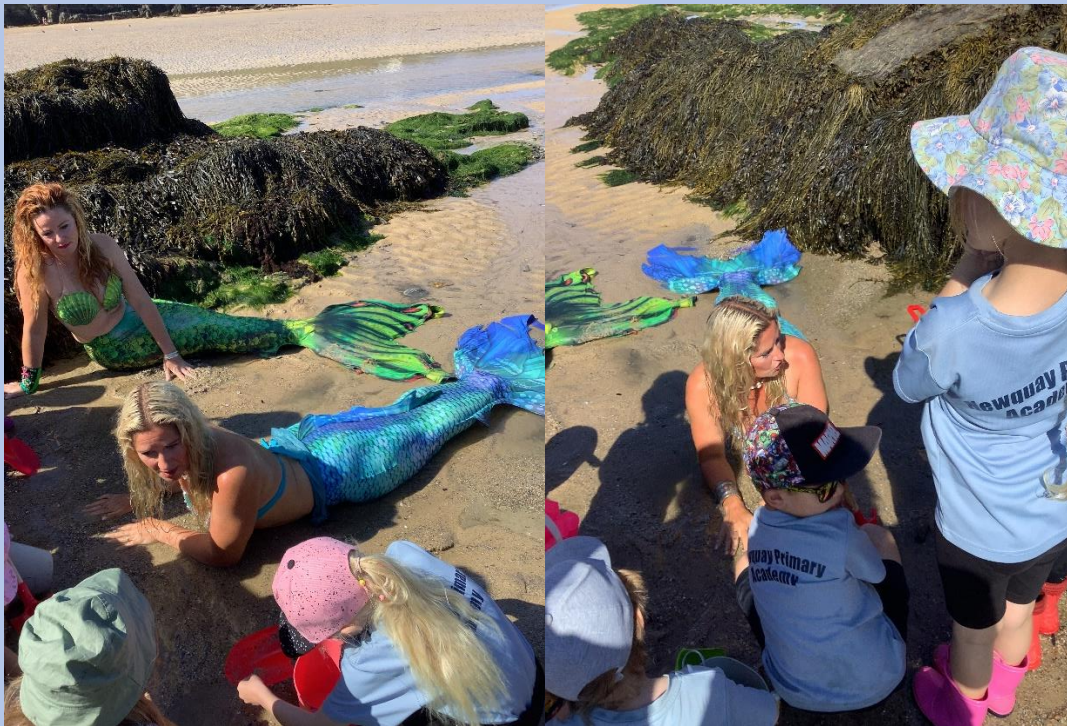
Footage claiming to show "real mermaids" on Porth Beach, Cornwall, went viral today after they were discovered by a local primary school.

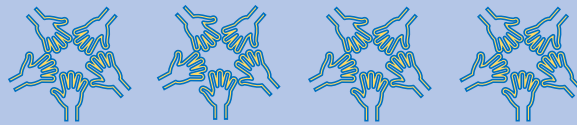
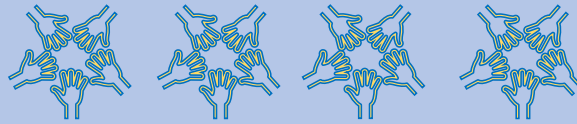
Star of the week

The heat is on...

The Met Office has extended an amber extreme heat warning for Sunday 17 July, Monday 18 July and Tuesday 19 July, as temperatures will build this weekend and early next week for much of England and Wales.

The amber warning highlights likely adverse health effects for the public, not just limited to those most vulnerable to extreme heat.







Temperatures could be around 32°C within the southwest, with Monday and Tuesday most likely to see temperatures around this level.

Please can all parents ensure that children arrive at the academy wearing appropriate clothing, sun hats with wide brims, plenty of water and with sunscreen already applied.

As an academy, we will be following clear government guidance on looking after children during heatwaves, including the use of ventilation, keeping children hydrated, and avoiding vigorous physical activity.

If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

Joshua Class summer performance – Octopus Island



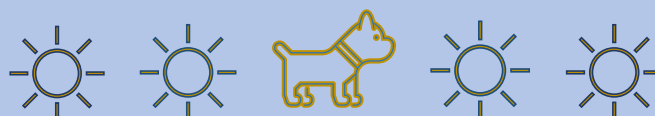
Joshua class would like to invite family and friends to attend a very special performance of 'Octopus Island' on Friday 22nd July at 12.45pm in the academy playground.
