If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence. Cornwall Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.

Flu Vaccinations

The School Nurse Team will be visiting Newquay Primary Academy on Friday 26th November. We are currently still awaiting on information from the school nurse team, and we will send this information out to all Parents as soon as we receive the pack.

Polite Reminder:

Please can we remind Parents/Carers to keep pupils close (preferably hold hands and not let pupils run ahead) when coming into school in the morning and leaving school at the end of the day, especially when entering the access road from the car park or back out from the school. Please use the pedestrian entrance in the main car park when dropping off/picking up the children. This pedestrian entrance is now clearly signposted.

As the weather is quite unpredictable as we move more into Autumn, please could you ensure that your child has their coat with them each day as we would still like them to enjoy the outdoors.
