 William Caxton introduced book publishing to England.
 -It was Thomas Farriner's bakery, on Pudding Lane, that started the Great Fire of London.
 -Samuel Pepys kept a diary and recorded the events of the Great Fire of London for people to read today.
 -Royal Mail is more than 500 years old.
 - Before the 1600s, only Royalty could post and receive letters. King Charles I changed this rule, so that everyone could use this service.
