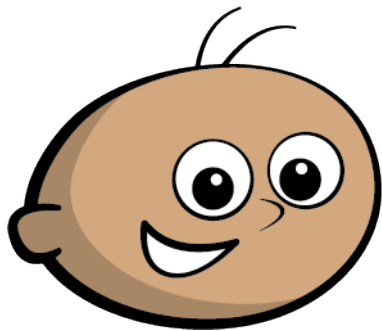


Tommy bakes two cakes.

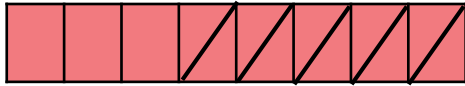
He cuts each cake into 8 pieces.

7 pieces from the second.



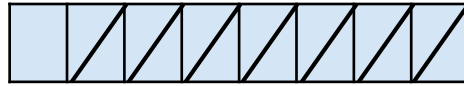
There is half a cake left.

True



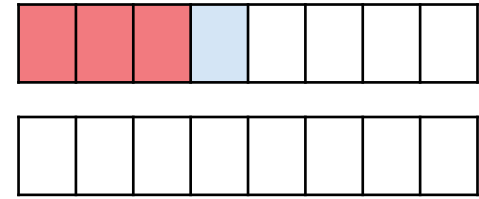
$$1 - \frac{5}{8} = \frac{3}{8}$$

First cake



$$1 - \frac{7}{8} = \frac{1}{8}$$

Second cake



$$\frac{3}{8} + \frac{1}{8} = \frac{4}{8}$$
